

The Board of Logan County Commissioners met on Monday, February 1, 2021. Those present were Commissioners Cameron Edwards, Cody Younkin and David Hubert. The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Chairman Cody Younkin.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Edwards to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Hubert respectively to approve the 2020 Annual Report for McAllaster Township. Motion carried unanimously.

The Board discussed the \$3,500.00 dues payable to Northwest Kansas Area Agency on Aging. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Edwards to pay the dues for 2021. Motion carried 3-0.

The minutes from the January 25, 2021 meeting was reviewed. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Hubert to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the January 29, 2021 Payroll Register as follows: General \$42,024.93; County Health \$12,104.56; Road & Bridge \$17,849.81; Noxious Weed \$3,161.70; Fire \$459.81 and EMS \$12,411.55 for a total of \$88,012.36. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Edwards respectively to approve the Payroll Register as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the Warrant Register dated January 29, 2021 as follows: General \$74,428.76; County Health \$1,923.16; Road & Bridge \$22,083.31; Noxious Weed \$325.26; Multi County Health \$56.84; Fire \$469.45; Prairie Dog \$11,416.50; Employee Benefits \$3,000.00; EMS \$931.08; County Bond & Interest \$19,164.67 and Payroll Clearing \$4,961.39 for a total of \$138,760.42. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Edwards respectively to approve the Warrant Register as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Hubert to approve the 2021 Annual Agreement for Maintenance, Repair and Construction of Township Roads for Paxton Township. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board invited all elected officials and department supervisors to join the meeting to discuss county Information Technology (IT). The Board wanted to hear their thoughts and ideas on the matter.

County Attorney Craig Uhrich joined the meeting. The Board phoned Jim Carlson with Kansas Natural Resource Coalition to discuss control of prairie dogs and a plan to move forward.

There being no further business discussed it was moved and seconded by Commissioners Edwards and Hubert respectively to adjourn the meeting at 10:40 a.m. The next regular meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, February 16, 2021 at 8:30 a.m.
