

The Board of Logan County Commissioners met for a special meeting on Wednesday, July 1, 2020. The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss Covid-19 and the statewide mask mandate by the Governor. Those present were Commissioners David Hubert, Cody Younkin and Cameron Edwards by phone. Chairman Edwards called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. Also attending were Rhonda Sperber, Brittany Siruta, Brianna Weiser, Pappy Lies, Joyce Bosserman, Donna Cox, Craig Uhrich, Chris Dorman and Brad Pendergast.

Discussion was held regarding the new statewide Executive Order No. 20-52 from Governor Kelly whereas effective at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, July 3, 2020, any person in Kansas shall cover their mouth and nose with a mask or other face covering. After some discussion and with only one positive confirmed case in Logan County, it was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Younkin to sign **Resolution #20-08, A Resolution Regarding the Use of Face Masks** whereas the Board determines the use of face masks in public is not required in Logan County, Kansas. The Board still strongly encourages safety measures as recommended by the county health officials.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Hubert and Younkin respectively to adjourn the meeting at 1:40 p.m. Motion carried.
