

The Board of Logan County Commissioners met on Monday, October 5, 2020. Those present were Commissioners Cameron Edwards, Cody Younkin and David Hubert by phone. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. by Chairman Cameron Edwards.

The Board met first over at the EMS Building. Also attending were: Celeste Rains, Craig Uhrich, Angie Kahle, Rhonda Sperber, Craig Wamsley, Pappy Lies, Aimee Zimmerman, Kandi Kuper and Ken Bockwinkel by phone. Angie Kahle was introduced as the new Logan County Health Administrator/RN. Kahle reported we now have 40 cases of the Coronavirus in Logan County with 27 active cases and 13 recovered. Discussion was held regarding the USD #274 Modified Quarantine Plan. The Board recessed at 8:30 a.m. and moved to the Commissioner Room.

Celeste Rains was sworn in as the new Logan County Health Officer.

It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Younkin and Hubert to approve the agenda with the addition of Bob Kelly at 9:00 a.m. Motion carried 3-0.

Emergency Management Director Pappy Lies met with the Board and gave an update for his department.

The minutes from the September 21 and October 2, 2020 meetings were reviewed. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Younkin and Hubert to approve both sets of minutes as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the Warrant Register dated September 30, 2020 as follows: General \$32,410.11; County Health \$14,617.79; Road & Bridge \$12,427.14; Noxious Weed \$983.94; Multi County Health \$68.38; Fire \$2,246.91; Prairie Dog \$10,380.00; EMS \$2,585.55; Drug Forfeiture \$8,998.00; Spark Funding \$266,834.56; County Bond & Interest \$2,230.00 and Payroll Clearing \$1,616.35 for a total of \$355,398.73. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Younkin and Hubert respectively to approve the Warrant Register as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the 10.75 hours of overtime for the Health Department in July.

The Board reviewed the September 30, 2020 Payroll Register as follows: General \$40,048.63; County Health \$11,114.60; Road & Bridge \$20,190.53; Noxious Weed \$3,476.62; Fire \$8,639.11 and EMS \$14,154.76 for a total of

\$97,624.25. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Younkin and Hubert respectively to approve the Payroll Register as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

EMS Director Bob Kelly met with the Board to discuss the upcoming EMT Class that starts November 2, 2020. The Board also discussed the agreement contract with instructor Brent Rouse.

The Board opened bids received for the 2004 Chevy Pickup as follows: Nathan Hales \$500.00. It was moved and seconded by Commissioners Younkin and Hubert to accept the bid for \$500.00 from Nathan Hales. Motion carried 3-0.

There being no further business discussed it was moved and seconded by Commissioners Younkin and Hubert respectively to adjourn the meeting at 9:20 a.m. The next regular meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 19, 2020 at 8:30 a.m.
